PARTNERSHIP WITH UACC

Providence is entering into a partnership with University Avenue Church of Christ (the church that owns this building). Through this partnership, God has blessed Providence with long term stability in a central (and very strategic) part of our city. This is something we have prayed for since we launched, so we are rejoicing in God's abundant provision for our church.

This partnership opens up the ability to move our Sunday service to the morning. After a thorough process, our leadership team **has made the decision to move to morning service starting December 11th**. Here are some answers to a few questions you might have:

Q: What exactly does this partnership mean for our two churches?

We will be moving to more of a shared approach in our relationship ... 1) Shared space: Providence will have greater access and use of the UA building throughout the week. 2) Shared costs: Providence is making a long-term financial commitment to help pay for the costs of operating the UA facilities. 3) Shared ministries: We will be joining together with UA for certain ministry initiatives and activities.

Q: Does this mean that our two churches will be merging?

In short, no. UA will continue to own and maintain the building, and we will be two churches operating in the same space. They will gather for worship at the same exact time as Providence in the campus center across the small parking lot.

Q: What time will our morning service start?

10:30am. This is the time that UA is currently meeting, and since we have opened our PK ministry to their children, we want to sync up with them on start time.

Q: How does this affect parking?

The only change to parking is that we will no longer be using the small lot between the main building and the campus center. We want to allow members of UA to have full access to those spaces. All other parking options will continue to be available. (*AT&T garage, the surface lot at MLK and Colorado, and the State Parking Garage E at 17th and Colorado.*)
