PROFESSION OF FAITH ADAPTED FROM 1 CORINTHIANS 15

We profess and affirm that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures. If Christ has not been raised, our faith is futile; and we are still in our sins. But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.
