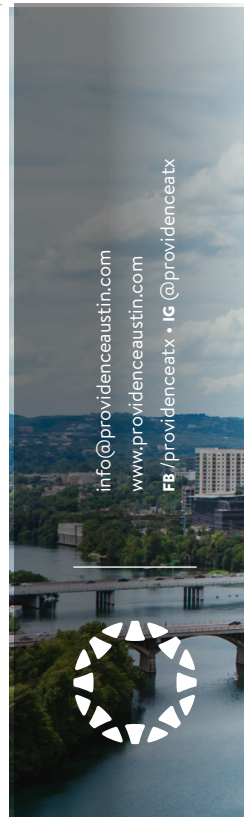
PROVIDENCE RECOVERY | EVERY THURSDAY • 7PM
