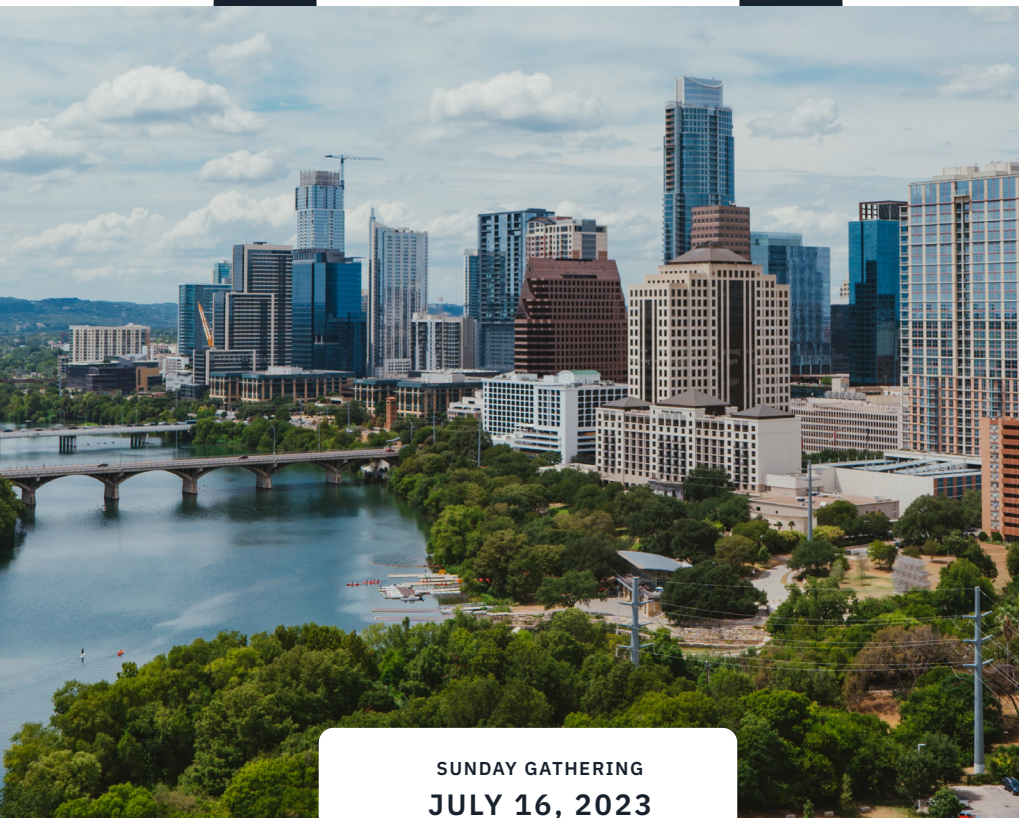

PROFESSION OF FAITH | WCF Ch. 15

We profess and affirm that repentance is a grace made available to us only by the gospel of Jesus. By repentance, we are made fully aware of the rebellion of our sins and the holy nature and righteous law of God. In this we come to understand God's mercy in Christ. Just as there is no sin so small, that is not deserving of condemnation; so there is no sin so great, that can bring condemnation upon those who truly repent. We must confess our sins to God and to those that have been affected by our sin so that we might be reconciled in love. This is true repentance.

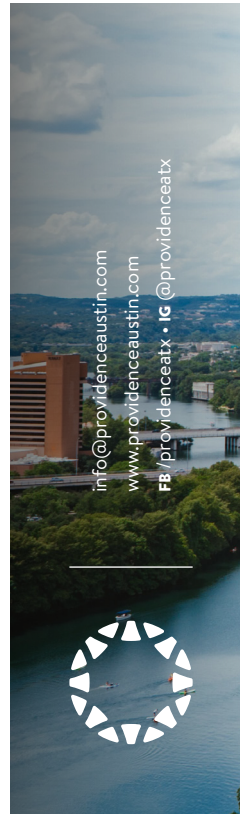
PROVIDENCE RECOVERY | EVERY THURSDAY • 7PM
