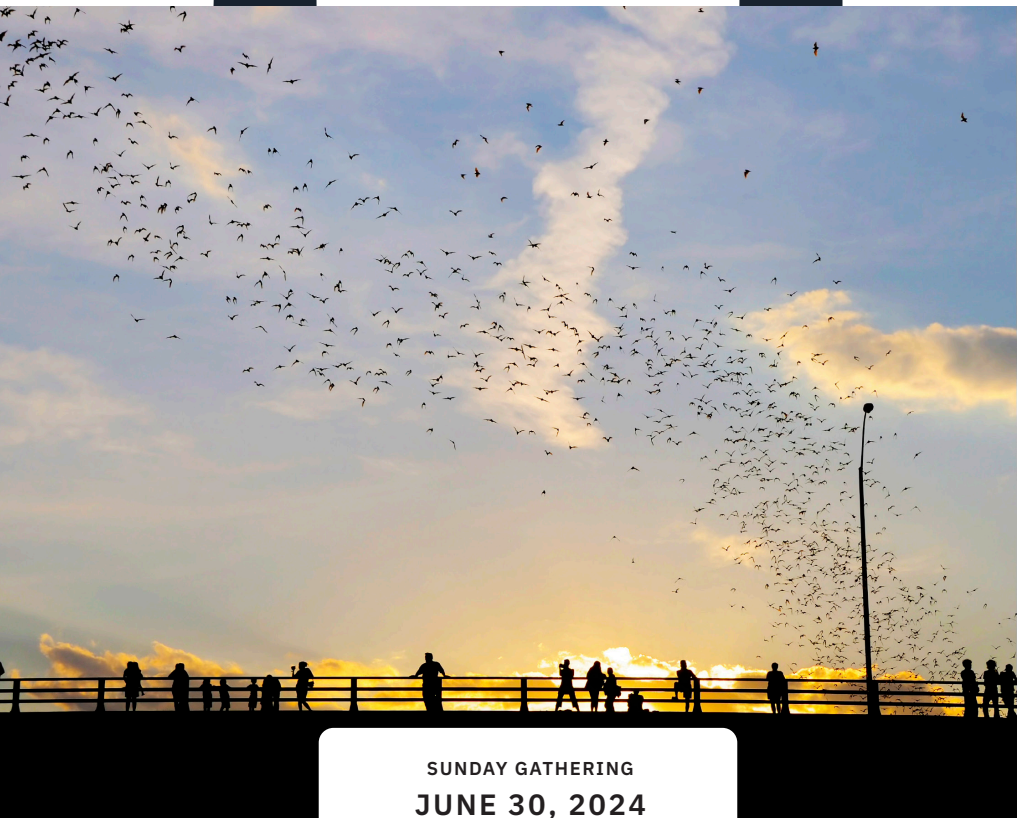

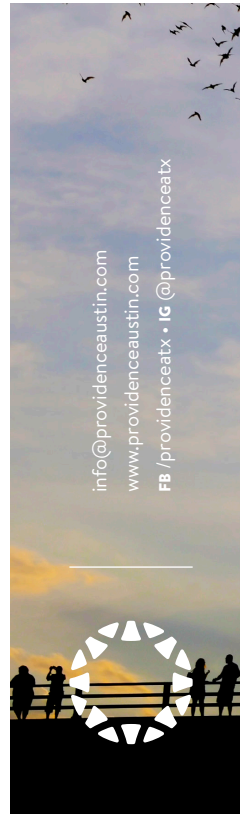
**HYMN SING | THURSDAY, JULY 18 • 7PM**
