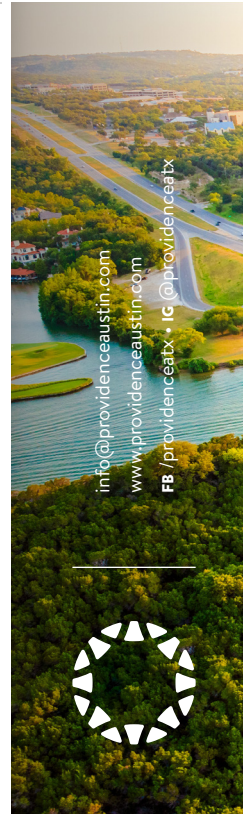
FIRST TIME MOM STUDY | MAY 27
