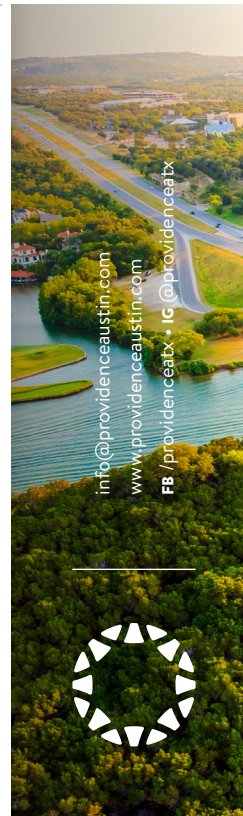
MINISTRY INTERNSHIP | APPLY BY JUNE 15
