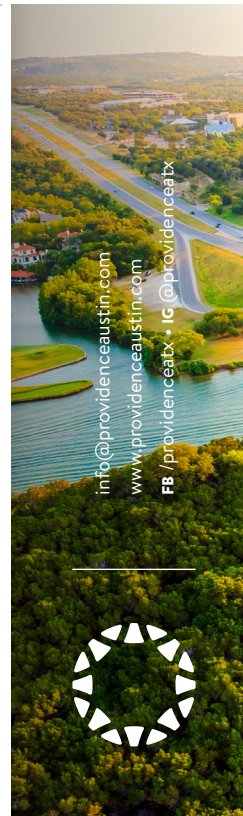
**MINISTRY INTERNSHIP** | APPLY BY JUNE 15
