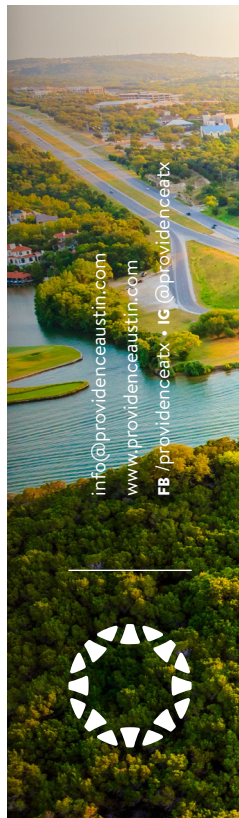
**TWO SERVICES | BEGINING AUGUST 16**
